## McCall Overview

St. Luke's McCall Medical Center is a critical access hospital serving Valley, Adams and Idaho counties. It is a leader in health and wellness promotion. Founded in 1956 as McCall Memorial Hospital, the medical center and clinics integrated with St. Luke's Health System in 2010. In 2023, we opened an expanded, modernized hospital and a new urgent care in the community. Our area network includes clinics in McCall, New Meadows and Riggins.
